DEATH OF HUGH JAMESON, Esq.—We regret to report the death of HUGH JAMESON, Esq., which event took place this morning, at his residence in this city. The deceased has long been known and respected in the mercantile community here. For many years he served as Deputy Surveyor of this port, the duties of which he discharged in a manner to secure the approval of all. He was removed for political reasons alone, and upon the accession of the present Administration, received the appointment of United States Naval Storekeeper, at the Charlestown Navy Yard. The deceased married a sister of President PIERCE, and was related to many prominent families in New-Hampshire. His death will be regretted by a wide circle of friends, who will bear willing testimony to the many amiable traits of his character, and to the fidelity with which he discharged the duties required of him in all the relations of life.—*Boston Transcript, 27th.*
